10am-12noon

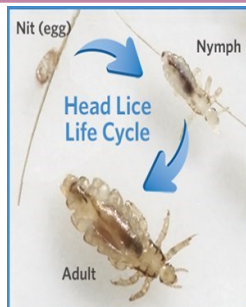
