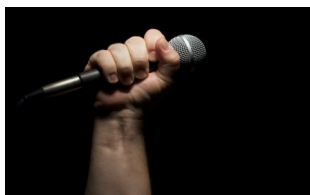

Jacket potatoes and a salad bar are also available everyday.

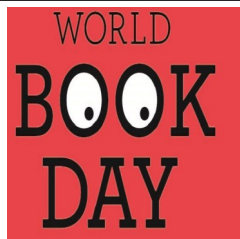
Have a look at the website for full details or stop by reception to pick up a menu. Dinners are £2.15 payable in advance or on the day.
