

This is how the children will be using the booklets in class. Below are some other ways you can help your child using these grids. Further grids will follow containing multiples of 5 and 10, multiples of 100 and random 2 digit numbers.

### Using the Number Challenge Booklet

- The booklet is to be used at least three times a week, although not necessarily in a numeracy lesson.
- Each child is to have their own booklet which they mark with a partner.
- The date and the time taken are recorded by the children. Maximum time for any task is two minutes. This can be shortened according to task and group. No time can be recorded if there is a wrong answer.
- When a child beats his/her own score at the same task, e.g. 5 times table, square numbers, then they can colour in a Smiley Face on the back.
- Any child who has four complete rows coloured in during any one half term will be awarded a certificate in assembly.
- Children who are not finishing in the time allocated can use their total as their target to beat after the third time.
