

In order to help you understand your child's level we have put together the following grid. On the table below you will find all the levels with an age appropriate guide to help you understand whether your child is of average, below or above average ability. For example, if your child at the end of Year 4 and has a level of 3B they are of average ability, however if they are Year 4 but with a level of 4C they are a higher achiever.

Please note that age appropriate levels are decided by the government and not by Oakwood Junior School.

At KS2 the expected progress is 2 levels of attainment.

E.g. if a child enters here on a 2B they should leave on a 4B

if a child enters here on a 3A they should leave on a 5A

KS1 = Reception, Year 1,2 (Infant School)

KS2= Years 3, 4, 5, 6 (Junior School)
