Learning is a two way partnership, involving school and home. Here are some ideas to help you with your child's learning:

TRANSITION

The children will be visiting their secondary schools during the next few weeks in preparation for September.

Class time will be spent discussing concerns and worries about this important move. The differences between secondary and junior school settings will be explored so that the children are given as much information as possible about their transition.

TOPIC

We will be looking at the Caribbean as a group of islands - asking geographical questions. Children will be learning about the culture and life, including art, dance and music. They will use their knowledge and understanding to create their own imaginary Caribbean island.

This will culminate in a 'One World' celebration event in July.

INDEPENDENT PROJECT

Homework for the remainder of the term is an independent research project. Your child will be given 1 hour of ICT (computer) time per week. All children will have selected their topic before half term, ready to start their project.

SCIENCE
