

Targets

Children are given targets for both English and Mathematics and are reviewed on a termly basis. These targets are shared with both the child and parent/carer.

Children also receive half termly targets for their "Attitude and Behaviours" within school. These include attendance, homework, uniform, effort, punctuality and PE kit.

School Uniform

We want all our children to look smart whilst in school. Wearing a uniform gives children a sense of belonging and pride.

Shirt/polo shirt - white

Cardigan/jumper/sweatshirt - Bottle green (can be purchased from school)

Trousers/shorts/skirt/dress - Black or grey

Socks - white or black

Tights - black or green

Shoes - flat black shoes

Tie - optional (can be purchased from school)

PE Kit

Indoor lessons: Black shorts, jogging trousers and a white T-shirt. Pumps may be worn though bare feet are best as feet become stronger and more sensitive, as footwork develops. Trainers are entirely unsuitable and are not allowed for indoor P.E.

Outdoor lessons: As above or a long sleeved sweatshirt or black track-suit. Trainers may be worn. For health and safety reasons football boots and shin pads must be worn for football club and football training.
