

## Targets

Children are given targets for both English and Mathematics and are reviewed on a termly basis. These targets are shared with both the child and parent/carer.

Children also receive half termly targets for their "Attitude and Behaviours" within school. These include attendance, homework, uniform, effort, punctuality and PE kit.

## School Uniform

## PE Kit

**Outdoor lessons:** As above or a long sleeved sweatshirt or black track-suit. Trainers may be worn. For health and safety reasons football boots and shin pads must be worn for football club and football training.
